

TOWNSHIP OF HAMILTON
ORDINANCE NO. 1833-2016

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCES 1758-2013, 1792-2015, 1811-2016, 1820-2016, AND 1821-2016.

WHEREAS, a common typographical error has been discovered in the referenced ordinances;

WHEREAS, the error does not affect the validity or applicability of the referenced ordinances, but may impact same in the event of a judicial challenge to any portion thereof;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Hamilton, County of Atlantic and State of New Jersey, that:

SECTION I. AMENDING ORDINANCE 1758-2013

The text of Section 3(a) is deleted and replaced with the following:

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, invalid, or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance. Except that this Ordinance shall not survive any determination by a court of competent jurisdiction that would result in this Ordinance authorizing the acquisition of title set forth in Section 1 hereto on a conditional basis or for good and valuable consideration.

SECTION II. AMENDING ORDINANCE 1792-2015

The text of Section 3(a) is deleted and replaced with the following:

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, invalid, or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

SECTION III. AMENDING ORDINANCE 1811-2016

The text of Section 11(a) is deleted and replaced with the following:

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, invalid, or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

SECTION IV. AMENDING ORDINANCE 1820-2016

The text of Section 3(a) is deleted and replaced with the following:

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, invalid, or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

SECTION V. AMENDING ORDINANCE 1821-2016

The text of Section 4(a) is deleted and replaced with the following:

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, invalid, or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

SECTION VI. SEVERABILITY and REPEALER

- (a) If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, invalid, or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.
- (b) Any Ordinance inconsistent with the terms of this Ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency

SECTION VII. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall take effect upon its final passage and publication as provided by law.
