

**TOWNSHIP OF HAMILTON  
ORDINANCE NO.: 1870-2018**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING EXHIBIT A, SECTION 1  
ARTICLE II OF CHAPTER 66 OF THE CODE OF THE  
TOWNSHIP OF HAMILTON, PROVIDING FOR THE  
MAXIMUM NUMBER OF EMPLOYEES**

**WHEREAS**, the Township Committee has determined that it is in the best interest of the Township to change the salary maximums for both the Division Chief Fire Sub Code Official from \$75,000 to \$25,000 and to change the Fire Official from \$25,000 to \$75,000 and;

**WHEREAS**, the Fire Official will become a full-time non union position, and the Fire Sub Code Official will become a part-time regular dual position.

**WHEREAS**, these changes will better reflect the duties of these two positions.

**WHEREAS**, the change outlined in this ordinance will not add any additional positions.

**WHEREAS**, this change will not add any additional cost to the budget.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Hamilton, County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey, that Article II of Chapter 66 of the Township Code, titled Personnel, shall be amended as follows:

**SECTION 1. Delete Position**

Amend the Staffing Chart to delete the one (1) FULL-TIME DEPUTIES AND DIVISION CHIEFS position of Division Chief Fire, Sub Code Official. Salary Maximum \$75,000

**SECTION 2. Create Position**

Amend the Staffing Chart to create one (1) PART-TIME REGULAR DUAL POSITIONS, position of Fire Sub Code Official. Salary Maximum \$25,000

**SECTION 3. Delete Position**

Amend the Staffing Chart to delete the one (1) PART-TIME REGULAR DUAL POSITION, position of Fire Official. Salary Maximum 25,000

**SECTION 4. Create Position**

Amend the Staffing Chart to create one (1) FULL-TIME DEPUTIES AND DIVISION CHIEFS position of Fire Official. Salary Maximum \$75,000

**SECTION 5. Severability and Effectiveness Clause.**

- (a) If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, invalid, or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.
- (b) Any Ordinance inconsistent with the terms of this Ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

**SECTION 6. Effective Date.**

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication as provided by in law.
