

**TOWNSHIP OF HAMILTON
ORDINANCE NO.: 1872-2018**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING EXHIBIT A, SECTION 1
ARTICLE II OF CHAPTER 66 OF THE CODE OF THE
TOWNSHIP OF HAMILTON, PROVIDING FOR THE
MAXIMUM NUMBER OF EMPLOYEES**

WHEREAS, the Township Committee has determined that it is in the best interest of the Township to change the salary maximum for the Executive Assistant in the Construction Office from \$45,000 to \$50,000 and;

WHEREAS, the Township Committee has determined that it is in the best interest of the Township to change the salary maximum for the On-Call Responders from \$3,000 to \$4,000 and;

WHEREAS, the Township Committee has determined that it is in the best interest of the Township to change the hourly rate maximum for the Special Police Officer Class II from \$20.00 per hour to \$21.00 per hour and;

WHEREAS, this change permits these positions to receive the 2% increase already approved by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the change outlined in this ordinance will not add any additional positions.

WHEREAS, this change will not add any additional cost to the budget.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Hamilton, County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey, that Article II of Chapter 66 of the Township Code, titled Personnel, shall be amended as follows:

SECTION 1. Change Position

Amend EXHIBIT A SECTION #1 Listing of all Non-Union Positions Maximum and Current Salaries and Wages by changing the Maximum Salary for the Executive Assistant in the Construction Office from a Salary Maximum of \$45,000 to a Salary Maximum of \$50,000.

SECTION 2. Change Position

Amend EXHIBIT A SECTION #1 Listing of all Non-Union Positions Maximum and Current Salaries and Wages by changing the Maximum Salary for the On-Call Responder from a Salary Maximum of \$3,000 to a Salary Maximum of \$4,000.

SECTION 3. Change Position

Amend EXHIBIT A SECTION #1 Listing of all Non-Union Positions Maximum and Current Salaries and Wages by changing the Maximum Hourly Rate for the Special Police Officers Class II from \$20.00 per hour to \$21.00 per hour.

SECTION 4. Severability and Effectiveness Clause.

- (a) If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, invalid, or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.
- (b) Any Ordinance inconsistent with the terms of this Ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 5. Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication as provided by in law.
