

April 27, 1998 Joint Meeting

The joint meeting of the Village of Hamilton Board of Trustees and the Municipal Utilities Commission was held on Monday, April 27, 1998 at 4:00 p.m. in the Village Office.

Present

Mayor Brink, Trustees McVaugh, Basher and Vantine, MUC President Hotaling, Commissioners Brink, Baker and Gustafson, Line Foreman Rhyde, Director of Utilities and Public Works Graham, and Village Administrator Kogut.

Streets, Water and Sewer Project Bid

Mr. Paul Sheneman gave a brief background regarding the project proposals. The project will include base bids 1, 2 & 3, deletion of the granite curb, super paving, and the extension of an 8" water line from College Street down Lebanon Street to where it will tie into the 6" main that is located at the road to Woodlawn Cemetery. The low bidder was Fahs-Rolston Paving, Inc. in Binghamton at \$965,963.72.

After further discussion, motion was made by Commissioner Baker, seconded by Trustee Basher and carried to award the bid to Fahs-Rolston Paving, Inc., including base bid 1b, base bid 2 and 2b, base bid 3, and Lebanon Street water line, not to exceed \$965,963.72, and signed by the Mayor or Village Administrator.
