

April 19, 1994 Special Meeting

The special meeting on the 1994-95 Village Budget was called to order at 7:26 pm by Mayor Baker in the Community Hall.

Present

Mayor Baker, Trustee Bergen, Brink and Glaser, and Clerk-Treasurer Kogut.

1994-95 Village Budget

Mayor Baker opened the special meeting of the Hamilton Village Board and asked for a motion to adopt the proposed 1994-95 Budget for the Village of Hamilton.

Motion was made by Trustee Bergen, seconded by Trustee Brink and carried to adopt the 1994-95 Village of Hamilton Budget.

Mid-York Senior Homes

Mayor Baker stated he received a letter from Dr. Michael Zahn, Chairman of the Planning Board, regarding the variances for the project. The Planning Board recommended granting the variances needed for parking and the sign. Mayor Baker remarked that as for the parking variance, the number of required parking spaces, has been changed from 24 to 16.

After further discussion, Mayor Baker asked for a motion to adopt the variance request for parking.

Motion was made by Trustee Brink, seconded by Trustee Glaser and carried to adopt the variance request for parking.

Mayor Baker stated that for the sign variance the proposed sign would be 15 square feet, which is larger than allowed in a residential district. After further discussion, Mayor Baker asked for a motion to adopt the variance request for a 15 square foot sign.

Motion was made by Trustee Bergen, seconded by Trustee Brink and carried to adopt the variance request for a 15 square foot sign.
