1949 Tax Rate

A motion was made by S. F. Jaquay, seconded by C. J. Betts and passed that the Tax Rate for the current year of 1949 be \$14.80 per \$1,000. of assessed valuation and that the Treasurer be directed to collect the Village Taxes at this established rate.

Recreation Commissioners

A motion was made by C. J. Betts, seconded by S. F. Jaquay and passed that Robert C. Roberts be reappointed for a term of three years and that R. Chester Roberts be appointed for a term of two years as members of the Recreation Commission.

Baum Resigns from Historical Commission

A motion was made by R. Chester Roberts, seconded by S. F. Jaquay and passed that the resignation of Carl W. Baum as member of the Historical Commission be accepted with regrets and that a letter of appreciation be sent to Mr. Baum in appreciation of his work while a member of the Commission.

Mayor Eccleston said he would talk with other members of the Commission asking for their recommendations for a successor to Mr. Baum.

The Board discussed Mr. Edward Vantines offer to lease the property at 9 Utica Street now occupied by the Municipal Office for one more year, rather than move the office to the U. S. O. Building as planned.
