

November 21, 1950

The meeting to hear complaints on Village assessments was held at the Village Office on Tuesday, November 21, 1950, between the hours of 3 and 5 P.M. A committee of the Board of Trustees was present and consisted of J. Leslie Flower, Charles A. Edkins, Robert D. Paul and John W. Auer.

Mr. Arnold Fisher appeared at the meeting requesting a decrease in his Lebanon Street assessments and also a request that a separate dwelling assessment be eliminated because he feels it should be considered a farm tenant house.

At the conclusion of the hearing the Board met to consider the adoption of the assessment roll. Present: Mayor C. A. Eccleston, Trustees R. D. Paul, R. Chester Roberts, Dr. J. H. Oates, and G. J. Betts, Assessors J. Leslie Flower and Charles A. Edkins, Clerk J. W. Auer.


The Board authorized the reduction in the assessment of the farm and house of Arnold Fisher from \$3,500 to \$3,200.

It was moved by R. Chester Roberts, seconded by R. D. Paul and passed that the assessment roll as prepared by the assessors with the reduction in assessment recorded above, be adopted.

School Bus Loading

At the request of Hamilton Central School and the recommendation of traffic experts, it was moved by R. Chester Roberts, seconded by R. D. Paul and passed authorizing the rerouting of traffic from the East portion of Broad Street in front of the school from 3:20 P.M. to 3:40 P.M. on school days and that the first and last bus driver is authorized to direct the rerouting of traffic during this period.
