

### February 2, 1954

The regular meeting of the Board of Trustees was held at the Village Office on February 2, 1954. Present: Mayor R. D. Paul, Trustees Dr. J. H. Oates, E. K. Elmer, C. F. Jaquay and Dr. R. Chester Roberts, Supt. M. V. Rasbach and Clerk J. W. Auer. Police Justice Harold H. Evans also attended the meeting. It was voted that the minutes of the last meeting be approved.

### Police Justice Salary

Mr. Evans explained to the Board the work required to be performed by the Police Justice. For the time necessary to carry out the work, Mr. Evans thought the position was underpaid. He suggested that the annual salary for this position be increased from \$600 to \$1,200. The Board told Mr. Evans that they would consider his request in preparing the tentative budget for 1954.

### Report of Unpaid Taxes

The report of unpaid taxes as of February 1, 1954 was presented to the Board by the Treasurer. It was moved by Dr. E. K. Elmer, seconded by C. F. Jaquay and passed that the report of unpaid taxes be turned over to the Village Attorney for collection.
