The meeting to hear complaints on Village assessments was held at the Village Office on Tuesday, November 16, 1954, between the hours of 1 and 5 P.M. J. Leslie Flower, Charles A. Edkins and J. W. Auer were present as a committee of the Board of Trustees.


Charles H. Husson, Andrew L. Lane and Daniel M. Warne appeared at the hearing to request a reduction in the assessment of the Baptist Church Parsonage at 70 Broad Street from \$4,500 to \$3,000.

At the conclusion of the hearing the Board met to consider the adoption of the assessment roll. Present: Mayor R. D. Paul, Trustees R. F. Stradling and Dr. R. Chester Roberts, Assessors J. Leslie Flower and Charles A. Edkins, Clerk J. W. Auer.

It was noted that all other parsonages in the Village were assessed at \$3,000.

On motion of Dr. R. Chester Roberts, seconded by R. F. Stradling, it was voted to adopt the assessment roll as prepared by the assessors with the exception that the assessment for the Baptist Church Parsonage at 70 Broad Street be reduced from \$4,500 to \$3,000.
