The regular meeting of the Board of Trustees was held jointly with the Board of Water, Light and Sewer Commrs. on October 4, 1955 at the Village Office. Present: Mayor R. D. Paul, Trustees C. F. Jaquay, Dr. E. K. Elmer and J. F. Wardwell, Commissioners J. M. Moses and S. F. Jaquay, Supt. E. O. Birkfeld and Clerk J. W. Auer. Trustee R. F. Stradling and Commissioner L. A. Cossitt were unable to attend.

The joint meeting was held to discuss with Mr. and Mrs. Ronald Snyder the possibility of extending the water main 1,600 ft. to serve their proposed new house on Lake Road.

Attending the meeting were Mr. and Mrs. Ronald Snyder and their son, their attorney William L. Burke, Edward Davies and Crawford Dain.

Speaking for the group, Mr. Burke quoted several sections of the Village Law which he stated required the Village to extend its water mains any distance on the demand of a taxpayer and that his clients were making this demand of the Village and since no other taxpayer has had to pay assessments permitted by law for such extensions, his clients did not expect to be assessed for making water service available to them.

The Snyders and Mr. Dain told of the possibility of several houses being built on Lake Road along the water extension demanded.

As no further discussion could be carried on by the joint Boards until this demand for water main extension was reviewed by the Village Attorney, Mayor Paul stated that the opinion of the Village Attorney would be secured and mailed to Mr. Snyder within a few days.

The minutes of the previous meeting were approved.

Health Officer Qualifies

A letter from the New York State Dept. of Health was read to the Board which stated that Dr. Montford Haslam had satisfactorily completed the course to meet the qualifications of a Grade II Health Officer.

Bids for Garbage Truck

After a discussion regarding specifications of the new garbage truck, it was moved by Dr. E. K. Elmer, seconded by C. F. Jaquay and passed that a bid notice be published requesting bids for a new garbage truck to be submitted by 1 p.m. on October 21, 1955 at which time the Village Board will meet to consider the bids received.

Walks in Park

Mr. Birkfeld told the Board about the condition of the walks in the Broad Street Park. The Board decided that the walks should be resurfaced. They also suggested that Mr. Birkfeld make provisions to feed the trees in this park.

Payment of Bills

It was moved by J. F. Wardwell, seconded by Dr. E. K. Elmer and passed that the bills listed on Abstracts of Audited Vouchers Nos. 26 and 27 be approved.
