The purpose of this special meeting was to receive bids for a new load compacting garbage truck.

The following bids which conformed to bid specifications were received:


Jones Motor Car Co.	\$6,879

The acceptance of a bid was delayed until the Board could study the bids. It was discovered that the bids submitted did not include tires of comparable sizes. In figuring the bids with the same size tires on each, the following figures were determined:

It was moved by Dr. E. K. Elmer, seconded by C. F. Jaquay and passed that the bid of the Jones Motor Car Co. of \$6,687 be accepted for the purchase of a new garbage truck.

Board of Water, Light Sewer
Comms. Minutes

November 18, 1955

The regular meeting of the Board of Water, Light and Sewer Comms. was held at the Village Office on November 18, 1955. Present: Commissioners J. M. Moses, S. F. Jaquay and L. A. Cossitt, Supt. E. O. Birkfeld and Clerk J. W. Auer.

Christmas Lighting

It was moved by L. A. Cossitt, seconded by S. F. Jaquay and passed that the Christmas Street Lights be installed and the Christmas Tree be erected in the park so that they may be lighted by December 9th.

Blue Cross Plan

As the Village employees have formed a group for membership in the Blue Cross Hospital Plan, it was moved by S. F. Jaquay, seconded by L. A. Cossitt and passed that the Board act as a collecting agent for the plan so that the employees may have the cost of membership deducted from their weekly payroll checks.

Additional Office Painting

It was moved by L. A. Cossitt, seconded by S. F. Jaquay and passed that, in addition to the work already authorized, the office of the County Public Health Nurse be painted and that linoleum be laid at a cost of about \$100.

Purchase of Poles

Mr. Birkfeld suggested to the Board that smaller quantities of poles be purchased rather than the usual carload lot as some poles have rotted on the pole rack while in stock.
