The regular meeting of the Board of Trustees was held at the Village Office on June 11, 1957. Present: Mayor J. F. Wardwell, Trustees Dr. E. K. Elmer, C. W. Taylor, E. D. Clark and R. F. Stradling, Supt. F. R. Ellison and Clerk J. W. Auer. The minutes of the previous meeting were approved.

State Building Code

Mr. Eugene J. Malone, Field Representative of the State Building Commission attended the meeting to explain the benefits that could be derived from adopting the State Building Code. C. A. Eccleston and H. E. Davey were invited to attend the meeting as building contractors and they stated that they were in favor of the Village adopting the code. Mr. Malone stressed the fact that the building code is a performance-type code which has many advantages over the specification-type code.

Since the building code is related directly to the Village planning project, it was moved by E. D. Clark, seconded by Dr. E. K. Elmer and passed that the State Building Construction Code be studied by the Planning Commission and that a recommendation be made to the Village Board regarding its adoption.

Enforcement Officer

It was moved by R. F. Stradling, seconded by C. W. Taylor and passed that Frank R. Ellison be appointed Enforcement Officer for the purpose of administering and enforcing the provisions of the Multiple Residence Law.

Request for Fuel Oil Bids

Deed to Lebanon Street Property
