The regular meeting of the Village Board of Trustees was held on Tuesday evening, March 8, 1966 at 7:30 P. M. in the Village Office. Present were Mayor E. K. Elmer, Trustees J. H. Wells, F. J. Lesperance, J. F. Warner and P. M. Jones, Engineer R. H. Albrecht and Clerk S. A. Burgess.

Minutes of the previous meetings were approved.

Appointment of Election Clerk

The clerk reported that Mrs. Wheeler could not accept an appointment as election clerk for this year's election.

It was moved by P. M. Jones, seconded by F. J. Lesperance and passed that Grenavere Todd be appointed election clerk for the village election to be held on March 15th.

Budget Hearing

It was moved by J. H. Wells, seconded by F. J. Lesperance and passed that the hearing on the 1966-1967 budget be held on April 12, 1966 between the hours of 7:30 and 8:30 P. M. in the Village Office.

Advertise for Bids - Diseased Elms

It was moved by F. J. Lesperance, seconded by J. F. Warner and passed that the Engineer be authorized to advertise for bids for the removal of diseased elm trees in the Village.

Non-Contributory Retirement

The following resolution was moved by P. M. Jones, seconded by J. F. Warner and unanimously adopted:

BE IT RESOLVED: that the Village Board of Trustees of the Village of Hamilton does hereby elect to come under the provisions of Chapter 339 of Laws of 1960, as presently or hereafter amended, and entitled "An act to amend the Retirement and Social Security Law, in relation to authorizing the provision of added pensions-providing-for-increased-take-home-pay and death benefits for officers and employees of participating employers in the New York State Employees' Retirement System"; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: that the members' contributions in the employ of the above shall be suspended and that the effective date of such suspension shall be the payroll period beginning on the 30th day of May, 1966.

Budget Review

Mr. Albrecht reviewed the tentative 1966-1967 budget estimator with the board. It was decided to increase the police department budget to allow for the employment of another policeman to provide for around the clock police protection.
