

Registration Day

The following resolution was offered by Trustee P. M. Jones and seconded by Trustee J. F. Warner who moved its adoption and it was duly carried unanimously.

WHEREAS the next general village election for officers will be held on March 21, 1967, and

WHEREAS no person shall be entitled to vote at any village election whose name does not appear on the register of the elections district in which he claims to be entitled to vote, and

WHEREAS it is the duty of inspectors of election to prepare such register of qualified voters for the district for which they are appointed, and

WHEREAS section 4-426 of the Village Law of the State of New York requires that every village hold a registration day for each general village election.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that

First: Registration day for the Village shall be held on Saturday the 4th day of March 1967.
