


South side of Kendrick Avenue, 60 feet West of the school driveway.

The regular meeting of the Village Board of Trustees was held on Tuesday evening, October 10, 1967, at 7:30 P. M. in the Village Office. Present were Mayor E. K. Elmer, Trustees J. H. Wells, P. M. Jones, R. D. Wilder and K. J. Lawrence, Engineer R. H. Albrecht and Clerk S. A. Burgess.

Minutes of the previous meetings were approved on motion by P. M. Jones, seconded by J. H. Wells and passed.

Request for Parade

A letter was received from Mr. Thomas Mulligan requesting permission for the Mokanna Grotto to hold a parade in the Village Streets on Saturday, October 14, 1967.

Motion was made by P. M. Jones, seconded by K. J. Lawrence and passed that permission be granted.
