CALL TO ORDER

 President Williams called the meeting to order at 6:40PM.

ROLL CALL

 The City Clerk called the roll and 5 members were present during roll call, namely: Ben Allatt, Jeff Baltimore, Brad Koplinski, Sandra R. Reid and Wanda R. D. Williams. Susan Brown-Wilson and Shamaine Daniels were absent.

INVOCATION/MOMENT OF SILENCE


 The Moment of Silence was led by Mr. Koplinski.


PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE


 The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Ms. Reid.

SESSION BUSINESS

 **The City Clerk read Bill 7-2015 into record** - An ordinance appropriating Community Development Block Grant funds from the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development for Fiscal Year 2015 and authorizing expenditure of such funds.

 Mr. Koplinski moved, seconded by Ms. Williams to make the following amendments: Reduce Debt Service from \$663, 546.00 to \$638, 567.00; Reduce CDBG Administration from \$396,808.00 to 429,826.00; Add \$29,000.00 to Christian Love Ministries; Reduce CRAM from \$100,000.00 to \$75,000.00; Reduce Tri-County from \$130,000.00 to \$100,000.00; Increase Fair Housing Council from \$120,000.00 to \$130,000.00; Reduce Camp Curtin YMCA from \$100,000.00 to \$80,000.00; Reduce Boys & Girls Club from \$67,000.00 to \$60,000.00; Increase Latino Hispanic American C.C. from \$50,000.00 to \$59,000.00; Increase Slum & Blight from \$108,114.00 to \$111, 114.00.

 President Williams called for the vote and the amendments passed 4-1, with Ms. Reid voting in the negative.

 Ms. Reid moved, seconded by Mr. Baltimore to make the following amendments: Reduce CRAM to \$50,000.00; reduce the Public Safety to \$225,000.00 and move \$50,000.00 to Public Works to implement the leaf collection system, yard waste and to fund a new position for billing.

- President Williams called for the vote and this failed 1-4.
- President Williams called for the vote for Bill 7-2015 As Amended and this passed 4-1.
- **The City clerk read Bill 8-2015 into record** - An ordinance appropriating Emergency Solutions Grant Program funds from the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development for Fiscal Year 2015 and authorizing expenditure of such funds.
- President Williams called for the vote and this passed 5-0.
- **The City Clerk read Bill 9-2015 into record** - An ordinance appropriating HOME Investment Partnerships Program (HOME) funds from The United States Department of Housing and Urban Development for Fiscal Year 2015 and authorizing expenditure of such funds.
- President Williams called for the vote and this passed 5-0.
