CALL TO ORDER

- President Williams called the meeting to order at 6:22PM.

ROLL CALL

- The Assistant City Clerk called the roll and 6 members were present during roll call, namely: Ben Allatt, Jeff Baltimore, Brad Koplinski, Sandra R. Reid, Susan Brown-Wilson and Wanda R. D. Williams. Shamaine Daniels was excused.

INVOCATION/MOMENT OF SILENCE

- The Moment of Silence was led by Mr. Koplinski

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

- The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Ms. Reid.

COMMUNICATIONS

- There were none.

COURTESY OF THE FLOOR

- Daniel D. Graham said that he was pleased to read in the Philadelphia Inquirer that Act 191 was struck down by the State Court. He expressed his gratitude that the City of Harrisburg could not be sued over the existing gun legislation. He congratulated Police Chief Carter and Mayor Papenfuse for standing firm with the City's existing gun legislation. He would like the City to require gun owners to report stolen or lost guns within two hours after discovering loss or theft. He would like a ban on semi-automatic guns, assault weapons and high capacity ammunition magazines.
- Mayor Papenfuse asked City Council to introduce legislation sent down by the Law Bureau prior to the meeting regarding the financing for the City's Street Light Project.

SESSION BUSINESS

- **The Assistant City Clerk read Resolution 59-2015 into record** – A Resolution approving the Preliminary/Final Land Development Plan submitted by Dave Butcher of WCI Partners, LP, to redevelop approximately 33,000 square feet of space into 33 residential apartment units as well as first-floor commercial space, located at 922 North 3rd Street.
- President Williams called for the vote and this passed 6-0.
- Ms. Brown-Wilson made a motion to move the Street Light Financing Legislation from the floor to the agenda in order to be placed into committee. It was seconded by Mr. Baltimore.
- Ms. Williams called for the vote and it failed with Mr. Koplinski, Ms. Reid, and Ms. Williams voting in the negative.
- Ms. Williams made an announcement that she along with Mr. Baltimore attended the 99th birthday celebration for Mrs. Zeni B. Travik. She wished her well and expressed a desire to see her on July 12, 2016 for her 100th birthday celebration.
 - Ms. Williams also announced that Learn and Laugh with Lacy, a summer babysitting service operated by Lacy C. Ray, a certified baby sitter, certified in
