CALL TO ORDER

- The meeting was called to order by President Williams at 7:24PM.

ROLL CALL

- The City Clerk called the roll and all 7 members were present, namely: Ben Allatt, Jeff Baltimore, Shamaine Daniels, Brad Koplinski, Sandra Reid, Susan Brown-Wilson and Wanda R. D. Williams.

SWEARING IN OF CITY TREASURER

- President Williams removed this from the agenda. Solicitor Neil Grover said that the selected City Treasurer Candidate Timothy East must be bonded before being sworn in.

COURTESY OF THE FLOOR

- Sheila Dow-Ford thanked the city for the process of selecting a new City Treasurer. In addition, she commended the EAC for all of their good work. She said that the shooting on Market Street was a “wake-up call” and that it is a shame that no one took leadership at the time of the city.
- Lewis Butts said that the bike lane on Front Street is not a good idea. He said that we should use what we already and make improvements.
- Les ford said that the School District of Harrisburg needs to be addressed. Public Safety and Education are the two most important things for this city to succeed and they need to take priority.

ORDINANCE FOR FINAL PASSAGE

- **The City Clerk read Bill 14-2014 into record** – An Ordinance of the City Council of the City of Harrisburg authorizing the City to enter into an Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement with Capital Region Water to authorize a non-exclusive cross-delegation of certain enforcement rights and powers to facilitate environmental compliance and assist in the ongoing provision of clean waterways and safe water in the Harrisburg region, and related matters.
- Mr. Grover stated that this Bill is to help the city and CRW move into a more compliant mode with regards to the water requirements environmentally. It helps both comply with State and Federal Laws and is consistent with what City Council voted on last year. (See audio for further discussion)
- President Williams called for the vote and this passed 7-0.
