- **Resolution 87-2016** - A Resolution approving a Domestic Animal Protective Services Agreement with the Humane Society of Harrisburg Area to provide services to the City of Harrisburg's Animal Control Program.
- **Resolution 88-2016** - A Resolution ratifying the submission of a grant application to Federal Emergency Management Agency ("FEMA") for the purpose of funding the purchase of fifty (50) air-line units and eighty (80) face pieces for the Bureau of Fire.
