ORDINANCES FOR FINAL PASSAGE

- **Bill 2-2017** - An Ordinance amending the City of Harrisburg's Official Traffic Control Map under Chapter 3-109 of the Codified Ordinances, by restricting parking on the West Side of South 18th Street between Derry and Berryhill Streets and authorizing the posting of No Parking signage consistent with the regulations of the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation.
- **Bill 3-2017** - An Ordinance of the City of Harrisburg, Dauphin County, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, electing to amend its Non-Uniform Municipal Pension Plan Administered by the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement System pursuant to Article IV of the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement Law; agreeing to be bound by all provisions of the Pennsylvania Retirement Law as amended and as applicable to member municipalities.
