ORDINANCES FOR FIRST READING

- **Bill 10-2017** – An Ordinance amending Chapter 2-701 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Harrisburg to limit any person from being elected to the office of Mayor more than twice and to limit any person who held the office of Mayor or acted as Mayor for a period of more than two years of a term to which some other person was elected as Mayor from being elected to the office of Mayor more than once; and amending related chapter headings.
- **Bill 11-2017** – An Ordinance Chapter 2-503 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Harrisburg on the organization of the Youth Commission and authorizing the creation of an application process for the selection of its youth members.
- **Bill 12-2017** – An Ordinance amending the City of Harrisburg’s Traffic Control Map pursuant to Chapter 3-109 of the Codified Ordinances by changing the flow of traffic of Goodwill Drive between Cameron Street and North 12th Street from a two-way street to a one-way street.
