ORDINANCES FOR FIRST READING

- **Bill 13 -2017** - An Ordinance establishing the budget for the Municipal Government of the City of Harrisburg for the year Two Thousand Eighteen (2018).
- **Bill 14-2017** – An Ordinance amending the Codified Ordinances of the City of Harrisburg, Title V, Licensing and Taxation, Part V, Real Estate Taxes, Chapter 5-501, Property Tax, by establishing for the year Two Thousand Eighteen (2018) a tax levy on land and improvements and providing for the distribution of taxes levied and assessed and providing for a tax rebate for the difference between the tax due and attributable to the year Two Thousand Eighteen (2018) tax levy over the tax due and attributable to the year Two Thousand Six (2006) tax levy for qualifying senior citizens.

## RESOLUTIONS

- **Resolution 74-2017** – A Resolution authorizing the City of Harrisburg to negotiate and enter into a professional services contract with Maverick Strategies for strategic guidance and intelligence gathering for lobbying related service.
- **Resolution 90-2017** - A Resolution approving the Second Amendment to a Lease, Licensing and Operating Agreement between the City of Harrisburg and the National Civil War Museum, modifying provisions to provide for the sale and purchase of the City-owned historical collection, providing for the payment of rents to the City, providing for the offsets of rents as a reimbursement for capital expenditures made in the course of operating the facility, providing for the establishment of both a building reserve fund and funding for the Reservoir Park Master Plan from proceeds of the sale of the historical collection and otherwise resolving the disputes of the parties.
- **Resolution 116-2017** - A Resolution approving the Seventh Proposed 2017 Budget Reallocation.
