ORDINANCES FOR FIRST READING

- **Bill 3-2018** - An Ordinance amending and reorganizing Part 3 of Title 9 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Harrisburg, entitled the “Municipal Waste and Recycling Code,” to reflect enhancements to the City’s collection and management of solid waste, recyclable and composting materials; to improve efficiencies in the collection of residential municipal waste fees by instituting annual billing; to provide a discount period; to identify prohibited acts which constitute violations of this Code; and to strengthen enforcement of this Code by authorizing the use of Enforcement Officer(s), and establishing fines and penalties for violations of this Code.

ORDINANCES FOR FINAL PASSAGE

- **Bill 2-2018** - An Ordinance approving the acceptance of loan funding by the City of Harrisburg from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Department of Transportation Infrastructure Bank in the amount of Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) for the purpose of restoring, repairing and improving streets within the City situated in south Harrisburg, including accessibility upgrades relating to Americans With Disabilities Act compliance.
