- **Bill 15-2018** - An ordinance amending part 3 of Title 9 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Harrisburg, entitled the “Municipal Waste, Recycling, and Composting Code,” to improve efficiencies in the collection of residential and commercial municipal waste fees by instituting annual billing; to provide a discount period for early payment; and to provide a penalty for late payment.
- **Bill 16-2018** - An Ordinance establishing the budget for the Municipal Government of the City of Harrisburg for the year Two Thousand Nineteen (2019).
- **Bill 17-2018** - An Ordinance amending the Codified Ordinances of the City of Harrisburg, Title V, Licensing and Taxation, Part V, Real Estate Taxes, Chapter 5-501, Property Tax, by establishing for the year Two Thousand Nineteen (2019) a tax levy on land and improvements and providing for the distribution of taxes levied and assessed and providing for a tax rebate for the difference between the tax due and attributable to the year Two Thousand Nineteen (2019) tax levy over the tax due and attributable to the year Two Thousand Six (2006) tax levy for qualifying senior citizens.
