- **Bill 13-2018** - An ordinance vacating and striking from the Official Map of the City of Harrisburg various unnamed paper streets within the block bounded by Maclay Street, North 7th Street, Peffer Street and Moltke Alley pursuant to Chapter 3-109 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Harrisburg.
- **Bill 16-2018** - An Ordinance establishing the budget for the Municipal Government of the City of Harrisburg for the year Two Thousand Nineteen (2019).
