RESOLUTIONS

- **Resolution 10 - 2019** – A Resolution approving a professional services agreement with Trout, Ebersole & Groff, LLP, CPAs and Business Advisors, to conduct a reconciliation of the Compensated Absences Liability and Neighborhood Fund Receivable accounts of the City of Harrisburg for the year ending December 31, 2018.
