ORDINANCES FOR FIRST READING

- **Bill 1-2020** - An Ordinance vacating and striking from the Official Map of the City of Harrisburg various unnamed paper streets within the block bounded by Harris Street, North 7th Street, Boyd Street and Wallace Street; Boyd Street between Wallace Street and North 7th Street; and Cowden Street between Boyd Street and Reily Street pursuant to Chapter 3-109 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Harrisburg.
- **Bill 2-2020** - An Ordinance amending the City of Harrisburg's Official Traffic Control Map pursuant to Chapter 3-109 of the Codified Ordinances by converting Hamilton Street and Harris Street from one-way to two-way operations between North 6th Street and North 7th Street and converting Clinton Street from one-way eastbound to one-way westbound between Wallace Street and North 7th Street.
- **Bill 3-2020** - An ordinance vacating and striking from the Official Map of the City of Harrisburg Minnie Alley within the block bounded by Moltke Alley and Wallace Street and Moltke Alley within the block bounded Maclay Street and Peffer Street pursuant to Chapter 3-109 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Harrisburg.

RESOLUTIONS

- **Resolution 1-2020** - A Resolution approving the Preliminary/Final Subdivision and Land Development Plan submitted by Brad Jones, President of South Second Associates, LLC, to convert an existing, office building located at 17th South 2nd Street into a residential apartment building with retail/restaurant space on the first floor.
- **Resolution 2-2020** - A Resolution authorizing the City of Harrisburg to enter into a professional services contract with Maverick Strategies for strategic guidance and intelligence gathering for lobbying-related services.
