A Resolution confirming the resumption of street cleaning schedules and enforcement of parking-related ordinances.

WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of Section 7501 of the Emergency Management Services Code, 35 Pa. C.S. § 7501, and consistent with the emergency proclamations and directives of the Governor, on the 16th day of March, 2020, the Mayor of the City of Harrisburg issued a *Declaration of Public Health COVID-19 Disaster Emergency*; and

WHEREAS, subsequent to the issuance of the initial Disaster Declaration, the Mayor issued a series of supplemental Declarations, Executive Orders and other directives to adjust municipal operations to respond to the ongoing global pandemic, including a Declaration of Temporary Suspension of Residential Parking Permit and Parking Meter Enforcement to ease the emergency-related financial burdens on City residents who have been made subject to the Governor’s closure of non-essential facilities and related work-from-home orders; and

WHEREAS, in the course of combatting the spread of the ongoing global pandemic, the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania now has adopted a series of Statewide health measures to allow for the resumption of some business, governmental and social activities; and

WHEREAS, this resumption of activity necessitates the City lifting or modifying those temporary emergency measures that suspended the enforcement of City Ordinances related to on-street parking and scheduled street cleaning activities, which activity shall recommence on Monday, June 15, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Harrisburg herein finds that citywide resumption of parking enforcement and scheduled street cleaning activities on Monday, June 15, 2020 to be in the best interest of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HARRISBURG that there shall be a resumption of both the enforcement of City Ordinances related to on-street parking and scheduled street cleaning activities, commencing on Monday, June 15, 2020.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any prior Resolution of Council, or part thereof, that approved and ordained the suspension of on-street parking enforcement and street cleaning activities during the course of the current global pandemic are hereby rescinded.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, Business Administer and other City staff are hereby authorized and directed to take such steps as are required to effectuate the purposes of this Resolution.
