- **Resolution 46-2020** - A Resolution authorizing the submission of a grant application to the Department of Homeland Security's 2020 Regional Catastrophic Preparedness Grant Program to fund projects that manage catastrophic incidents by improving and expanding regional collaboration for catastrophic incident preparedness.
