A Resolution appointing Kali Tennis to serve on the Harrisburg Architectural Review Board.

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the Codified Ordinances of the City of Harrisburg § 7-317.4, the City of Harrisburg shall appoint seven (7) members to the Harrisburg Architectural Review Board (the “Board”); and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to § 7-317.4.A., the members of the Board shall consist of one (1) registered architect, one (1) licensed real estate broker, (1) one Building Inspector of the City; and four (4) additional persons with a knowledge of and interest in preservation of the Historic Overlay District and reside therein; and

**WHEREAS**, appointments to the Board shall be made by the Mayor with the advice and consent of Council; and

**WHEREAS**, appointees to the Board shall be residents of the City of Harrisburg; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to § 7-317.4.C., appointees to the Board shall serve for a term of three (3) years or for the unexpired portion of a vacated term; and

**WHEREAS**, Ms. Tennis is a resident of the City of Harrisburg; and

**WHEREAS**, Ms. Tennis has knowledge of and interest in preservation of the Historic Overlay District and resides therein; and

**WHEREAS**, reposing confidence and trust in the ability of Ms. Tennis to capably perform the duties incumbent upon the position, the Mayor has appointed Ms. Tennis to serve on the Board; and

**WHEREAS**, there is a vacancy on the board due to the resignation of Mr. A.J. Knee (formerly Jordan) whose term is set to expire on September 24, 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to § 7-317.4.C., Ms. Tennis’s appointment shall be for the term of three (3) years and shall expire on \_\_\_\_\_, 2023; and

**WHEREAS**, Ms. Tennis’s qualifications to serve as a member of the Harrisburg Architectural Review Board have been reviewed and considered by Council. A copy of Ms. Tennis’s resume is attached and incorporated as “Exhibit A.”

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HARRISBURG,** that the appointment of Kali Tennis to serve on the Harrisburg Architectural Review Board is confirmed.
