COMMENTS FROM CHAIR

Community & Economic Development Committee

- Presentation by Penn State Students regarding Reservoir Park
- **Resolution 76-2020** - A Resolution approving a Preliminary/Final Land Development Plan to develop an approximately 200-space parking lot at 1501 North 7th Street.
- **Resolution 85-2020** - A Resolution of the Council of the City of Harrisburg to adopt a Comprehensive Plan in accordance with the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code.

Public Safety Committee

- **Bill -8-2020** - An Ordinance amending Part 5 of the Administrative Code under Chapter 2-500, adding thereto Chapter 2-515 to establish a Citizens Law Enforcement Advisory Committee.

Budget & Finance Committee

- **Resolution 71-2020** - A Resolution authorizing the City of Harrisburg to facilitate the completion of certain improvements in the ongoing MulDer Square project to be funded through the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania's Redevelopment Assistance Capital Program ("RACP") under an award made to the Redevelopment Authority of the City of Harrisburg; and otherwise approving the related "RACP Reimbursement Agreement" between the City and the Redevelopment Authority to advance reimbursable project costs in a sum no greater than three million dollars (\$3,000,000.00), in a manner consistent with the terms and conditions of the RACP grant.

Building & Housing Committee

- **Resolution 73-2020** - A Resolution appointing Kali Tennis to serve on the Harrisburg Architectural Review Board.
- **Resolution 78-2020** - A Resolution authorizing the City of Harrisburg to negotiate and enter into a professional services contract with Steve Zimmerman to provide access and service of the City's historical mainframe programming operations and related services in the Bureau of Information Technology.

Public Works Committee

- **Resolution 79-2020** - A Resolution authorizing the submission of a grant application to the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation Multimodal Transportation Fund for up to nine hundred and seventy-two thousand seven hundred and thirty dollars (\$972,730.00) to help fund the construction of the Courthouse Connection Multimodal Project.

- [Resolution 81-2020](#) - A Resolution authorizing the City of Harrisburg to negotiate and enter into a final agreement with the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation arising from the Harrisburg Strong Plan; to secure a reimbursement of funds up to two million eight hundred and ninety-two thousand four hundred and seven dollars (\$2,892,407.00) through the statewide Multimodal Transportation program; and to thereby assist with the ongoing North Second Street Multimodal Project.
- [Resolution 82-2020](#) - A Resolution authorizing a final agreement to resolve certain disputes arising from a 2014 Lease Agreement of certain properties serving as the City's primary Public Works facilities.
