ORDINANCES FOR FIRST READING

- **Bill 21-2020** - An Emergency Ordinance amending Chapter 3-355 of Title 3, the Public Safety Code, by adding Part 2, Supplemental Emergency Powers, to provide temporary direct supplemental local authority to implement remedial measures to address public health emergencies during an extended State of Emergency, including moratoriums on the eviction, ejection or removal of families, households or individuals from a residential dwelling unit or rooming house; providing exceptions thereto; providing increased fines and penalties for violators; authorizing the adoption of emergency regulations; and making technical conforming amendments.

- [Bill 12-2020](#) - An Ordinance amending zoning regulations related to the establishment and operation of Bed & Breakfast uses including Chapters 7-305.7(B), 7-305.7(C), 7-309.2(h), and 7-333.2(a)(24) of the Zoning Code of the City of Harrisburg.
- **President Williams called for the vote and this passed As Amended, 7-0 on December 10, 2020.**
- [Bill 14-2020](#) - An Ordinance establishing the budget for the Municipal Government of the City of Harrisburg for the year Two Thousand Twenty-One (2021).
- [Bill 15-2020](#) - An Ordinance amending the Codified Ordinances of the City of Harrisburg, Title V, Licensing and Taxation, Part V, Real Estate Taxes, Chapter 5-501, Property Tax, by establishing for the year Two Thousand Twenty One (2021) a tax levy on land and improvements and providing for the distribution of taxes levied and assessed and providing for a tax rebate for the difference between the tax due and attributable to the year Two Thousand Twenty One (2021) tax levy over the tax due and attributable to the year Two Thousand Six (2006) tax levy for qualifying senior citizens.

- [Resolution 96-2020](#) - A Resolution authorizing the City of Harrisburg to negotiate and enter into an intergovernmental cooperation agreement with the Borough of Paxtang for the purpose of authorizing the City to provide municipal solid waste and recycling collection and disposal services within the Borough.

- **Resolution 100-2020** - A Resolution declaring that the ongoing novel COVID-19 pandemic constitutes an emergency of such magnitude and threat to the health, welfare, and safety in the City of Harrisburg that emergency legislative action is necessary so as to allow the concurrent proposed Emergency Ordinance, Bill 21- 2020, amending Chapter 3-355 “State of Emergency” of the Codified Ordinances of Harrisburg to be effective immediately.
