**Hillsborough Emergency Services Partners for a River
Clean-Up Day – Sunday, May 31st from 9am – 2pm,
Dukes Parkway Park in Manville
*Live River Rescue Demonstration at 1pm***

All Township residents are invited to attend and participate in the Raritan River Clean-Up Day on Sunday, May 31st from 9am until 2pm at Dukes Parkway Park in Manville, announced Committeewoman Gloria McCauley at Tuesday's Township Committee meeting.

Supplies and instruction for the clean-up will be provided by the Central Jersey Stream Team.

"This collaborative effort between Hillsborough, Manville, Franklin and Somerville, is a testament to the dedication of the safety of all area residents," added Committeewoman McCauley.

In addition to the actual river clean-up activities, various emergency and rescue equipment will be on display from 11 am until 1 pm. There will be a live river rescue demonstration at 1 pm. The rain date for the event is Sunday, June 7th.

"Witness firsthand the expertise of the area's Emergency Services Agencies such as Hillsborough Township's Emergency Services who have the capability in river rescue," concluded Committeewoman McCauley.
