

## **School Threats A Serious Matter for Hillsborough Police**

Hillsborough Police Chief Paul Kaminsky has issued the following statement regarding recent threats at Hillsborough High School:

"The Hillsborough Police Departments takes these threats very seriously. Our job first and foremost is the protection of school children and school staff in these situations and concurrently finding and stopping the perpetrator or perpetrators of these threats.

And, working with the Somerset County Prosecutor's Office and Sheriff's Office, as well as other law enforcement agencies, we are using every resource available to ensure safety in our schools."

Mayor Anthony Ferrera stated, "The situation is real concern for parents and school kids and difficult for the Police. The Township Committee has the utmost confidence in the Police Department's professional handling of the matter."
