AN ORDINANCE
TO AMEND
CHAPTER 123
OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MAPLEWOOD
ENTITLED
"Fees"

"Interpretive Statement"

This ordinance amends Chapter 123 of the Code of the Township of Maplewood dealing with fees for solar collector.

WHEREAS, the Township of Maplewood ("Township") has adopted new ordinances regarding the use of Solar Collectors; and

WHEREAS, the fees incidental to the installation of Solar Collectors need revisions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Maplewood, County of Essex, State of New Jersey that Chapter 123 of the Code of the Township of Maplewood be amended as follows:

FIRST: Chapter 123, Fees be amended as Follows:

Chapter 93: Building Construction

Solar Systems:

Building Permit and Review	\$75.00
Electrical Permit and Inspection	\$75.00

All other Sections shall remain unchanged.

SECOND: Severability

If any section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the specific section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

THIRD: Repeal of Prior Ordinances

Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of any such inconsistencies.

FOURTH: Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect after final passage and publication and as provided by law and upon notice by certified mail, return receipt requested to the Municipal Clerk of all adjoining Municipalities and to the Essex County Planning Board.

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that the foregoing proposed Ordinance was introduced and read by title at a meeting of the Township Committee of the Township of Maplewood, held on February 20, 2018, and that the Township Committee met again on March 20, 2018, at the Municipal Building, 574 Valley Street, Maplewood, New Jersey, at which time and place the Township Committee held a hearing and proceeded to consider the said Ordinance on *final reading and final passage*.
