**RESOLUTION CALLING FOR
RESCHEDULING OF PUBLIC HEARING ON A
PROPOSED LOCAL LAW REGARDING
ENERGY CONSERVATION CONSTRUCTION LAWS,
MULTIPLE RESIDENCE LAWS,
UNIFORM FIRE PREVENTION AND BUILDING CODE LAWS**

Mr. Dale Hallings, offered the following Resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, a proposed Local Law, in regard to the administration and enforcement of the Energy Conservation Construction Code of New York State, Multiple Residence Law of New York State and New York State Uniform Fire Prevention and Building Code in the Town of Milo, which state codes establish the minimum requirements to safeguard the public health, safety and general welfare through structural strength, means of egress facilities, stability, sanitation, adequate light and ventilation, energy conservation, and safety to life and property from fire and other hazards attributed to the built environment and to provide safety to fire fighters and emergency responders during emergency operations, has been presented to the Town Board of the Town of Milo, and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Milo has reviewed the aforementioned proposed Local Law, attached hereto as Schedule "A", and deems it in the best interests of the Town of Milo to proceed in accordance with the Code of the Town of Milo and the Laws of the State of New York in adopting said Local Law, and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Milo has determined that this proposed Local Law is now in its Final Form, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing on this proposed Local Law is required before it may be enacted, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Milo Town Board Resolution #77-2017, a public hearing, in regard to the enactment of the above referred to Local Law, was scheduled for January 16, 2018 at 7:00 p.m. at the Town of Milo Town Office, but due to an oversight by the Town attorney, a legal notice in regard to said public hearing was not timely delivered to the official Town newspaper, in order that the required public notice be published in the official Town newspaper.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT

RESOLVED & ORDERED, that the public hearing, in regard to the enactment of the proposed Local Law, in regard to the administration and enforcement of the Energy Conservation Construction Code of New York State, Multiple Residence Law of New York State and New York State Uniform Fire Prevention and Building Code in the Town of Milo, shall be rescheduled for February 20, 2018 at 7:00 p.m. or soon thereafter at the Town of Milo Town Office, 137 Main Street, Penn Yan, New York, during its regular meeting, to consider this proposed legislation, and it is further

RESOLVED & ORDERED, that the Town Clerk be, and she hereby, is authorized to forward to the official newspaper of the town, a Notice of Public Hearing, and it is further

RESOLVED & ORDERED, that the Town Clerk be, and she hereby, is directed to post a Notice of said hearing and a copy of the proposed Local Law on the Town of Milo signboard and take any and all necessary actions to properly bring the aforementioned Local Law before the Town Board of the Town of Milo for its consideration, and it is further

RESOLVED & ORDERED, that the Town Clerk be, and she hereby, is authorized to provide all other notices, if any, as required by law for the adoption of this Local Law.
