It finally has happened. The boarded-up house on Main Street has been demolished. It took a lot of time and work by a number of people to get this to happen. Thanks to Richard Schaus, Village Attorney, and Phil Trembley, Code Enforcement Officer, for the time they put into the project.

I have been reappointed to the Erie County Sewer District No. 2 Board. By being on this Board, I am made aware of what is going on with our sewer system throughout the Village.

Just to give you a heads-up...we have a new company that will be picking up garbage starting in June. The only change from our present collector is the pickup date, which will be on Friday instead of Wednesday.

I want to thank all the residents who cooperated in keeping their vehicles off of the streets during the winter. This made it so much easier in plowing the streets.

Matt Sweet has been appointed to the Village/Town Planning Board.

### Coming in 2016:

- 1.) Eden-North Collins Food Pantry will start construction of their building on Franklin Street in May. Thanks again to Jim Smith of American Wire and Tie for donating this land to the Pantry.
- 2.) The village will begin purchasing new water meters. Eventually we will be replacing all the meters in the village. With the new meters, we will not have to come on your property to read meters. The reading will be done from the street by a remote control system.

The Village received a \$100,000 Community Development Grant. The grant is for replacing sidewalks on both sides of Kimble and Orchard Place and a new sidewalk on Franklin Street going up to the Food Pantry.

The new trackless sidewalk snow blower has really paid off as far as time saved in plowing our sidewalks. It now takes less than half the time it took before to plow the sidewalks.

After 19 years of service in both village and town government, Brenda Bauer-Petrus has decided not to run for re-election for Village Trustee. On behalf of the residents and myself, we want to thank Brenda for her many years of devoted interest and service in the betterment of our community.

Mrs. Jan Hutchinson is presently in training to become our new village clerk. Mrs. Hutchinson has the experience and background to fit right into this position, making this a smooth transition in the working our village office.

- 591 Traffic tickets were issued
- The Town of North Collins Court received a total of \$42,863.00 in fines and revenues from traffic tickets
- Provided 30 funeral escorts at a cost of \$1,560.00
- Provided police officers for 45 Town Court session at a cost of \$2,925.00

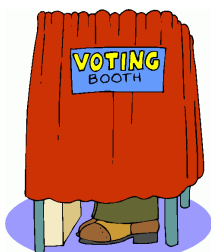
