We are very excited about what has been and is happening in the village.

Homes that have been abandoned or up for sale have been selling. In one week, three homes have sold in the village. Many homeowners have put on new siding, windows, roofs, and fences along with landscaping their property.

Business is also picking up. Coming back to life is the old Speedy's building on Main Street. Joe Popjanevski, owner of 3 Star Restaurant, purchased the building and is remodeling it into a more upscale, family restaurant. A new online business, Custom Decal Designs, owned and operated by Christine Cappola right here in the Village, can be found on Facebook. On High Street, Melissa Kapuszak owns and operates a LuLaRoe clothing boutique. This past year, we have also seen Speedy's Cut & Color Hair Salon, Forever Green Landscaping, The Laundromat, and Let it Shine auto detailing and dent repair open a business in or near our Village.

Garbage Pickup is early FRIDAY mornings by Bestway Disposal (phone: 672-7237). Please set it out the night before. Pickup is delayed one day if an official holiday falls within the week. (A calendar is available online or from the Village Office.)

They will pick up FIVE (5) bags of garbage or two (2) 30-gallon garbage cans of refuse from each residence each week. Must be in waterproof containers. *Yard waste of any kind will not be picked up.*

Bestway will pick up recycling on a weekly basis. They have provided recycling bins. If you did not receive one, please contact the Village Clerk.

Bestway will also pick up two (2) bulk items each week as well as two (2) white items such as household appliances each week. All these items must be under 80 pounds. Furnaces will not be picked up nor will items that contain Freon (refrigerators, humidifiers, air conditioners, etc.)
