

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE VILLAGE OF NORTH COLLINS ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS HELD ON June 5, 1978 AT 7:30 P.M. IN THE VILLAGE HALL.

Meeting called to order at 7:30 pm by chairman Lou Fricano.
Board members present: Peter Bottoni, Robert Haumesser, Victor Ellero and Ralph Jesweld.

Mr. Edward Awald requested a sign permit. Sign to be erected on Mr. & Mrs. Christy Pisa's property at 10696 Main Street, North Collins, NY.

Members granted Mr. Awald a special permit use. Sign to be erected on said property to advertise fruit and vegetables. Sign shall not exceed 2 feet by 3 feet. It shall be securely mounted on its own mount and shall not obstruct vision from cars exiting from Gurney Avenue. Sign shall be erected beginning June 1 and shall be removed Sept 30th. Permission granted for 3 years 1978, 1979, 1980. This special permit use is for Mr. Awald only.

Letter was received with objections to the sign: Volume of traffic, the noise, dust and the endangerment of children and pedestrians. The sign is unlawful and forbidden in a residential district. The business is situated in the Town of Brant. The sale of these products is mercantile. We plead to our village officials to give us the privacy of a residential neighborhood.
