

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE VILLAGE OF NORTH COLLINS ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS HELD ON October 25, 1978 AT 7:30 P.M. IN THE VILLAGE HALL.

This is a public hearing of the Zoning Board of Appeals.

**Meeting called to order at 7:33 pm by Lou Fricano Chairman
Members present were L. Fricano, R. Haumesser and Ralph Jeswald.**

L. Fricano explained to visitors the above covering gasoline filling and service stations. Mr. L. Quiter and T. O'Boyle asked about repair of autos outside. It was explained to him only emergency repairs can be done outside of the building. There were no other questions.

Pertaining to Section 123-3 page 12306 paragraph 9 of the Village Zoning Manual.

We were asked to define what constitutes minor repairs for a filing station. After asking different garages and mechanics and getting their version of what minor repairs were, this is what we came up with.

- 1. Selling and changing tires.**
- 2. Lubrication and oil change**
- 3. Minor engine tune-up: condensers, points, spark plugs and carburetor adjustment, changing spark plugs wires.**
- 4. Wash and polish cars**
- 5. Replace exterior components of car engine, no internal work on engine and drive train.**
- 6. Replace exhaust components but no torch shall be used.**
- 7. All minor work to be conducted inside of building except in cases of emergency**
- 8. Strictly no collision service or car painting.**
- 9. No welding**
- 10. Can replace brake shoe and wheel cylinders.**

Time for doing minor work from 9 am to 11 pm.
