

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE VILLAGE OF NORTH COLLINS ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS HELD ON October 2, 1979 AT 7:30 P.M. IN THE VILLAGE HALL.

Meeting brought to order at 7:02 pm by chairman Lou Fricano.

Members present were Lou Fricano, Robert Haumesser and Ralph Jeswald. Also present were David Tarshis, building inspector and Gary Bacon, fire inspector. Also present was John Downes, owner of the building on Main Street requiring a special use permit for a multiple dwelling unit.

John explained to us exactly what he has in mind for this building. He answered questions from the board about fire safety, garbage, parking and other concerns of the tenants who may live there.

Lou dismissed the building inspector and fire inspector after John left the meeting.

It was the unanimous decision of the board members present to grant a special use permit for 10538 Main Street for construction and occupancy for 10538 Main Street in accordance with the application submitted by John Downes dated 9-12-79. Said permit will remain in effect only so long as Mr. Downes retains ownership of the said property. Change of ownership shall require an application for a special use permit for continued occupancy.
