CURRENT PROJECT STATUS

Monroe County Department of Transportation and the project design consultant (Wendel WD) have completed a review of the existing rustic (brown color) guide railing system on Trimmer Road just south of Pine Hill Road.

As documented by the New York State Department of Transportation, the past practice of installing rustic (or brown patina) guide railing is no longer considered an acceptable roadside treatment. The rustic railing metal material is deteriorating at an unexpected accelerated rate from the inside out. Therefore, these rustic railing systems throughout Monroe County are being decommissioned and replaced with standard galvanized steel guide railing. The new guide railing systems will be installed in accordance with the current design standards. On the backside of this newsletter is a diagram of the proposed layout for this location, designed per the current standards.

The Rustic Railing Replacement project is scheduled to begin in mid September, with the work expected to take a few days to complete. During the construction, two-way traffic will be maintained utilizing flag persons to direct traffic flow as needed.

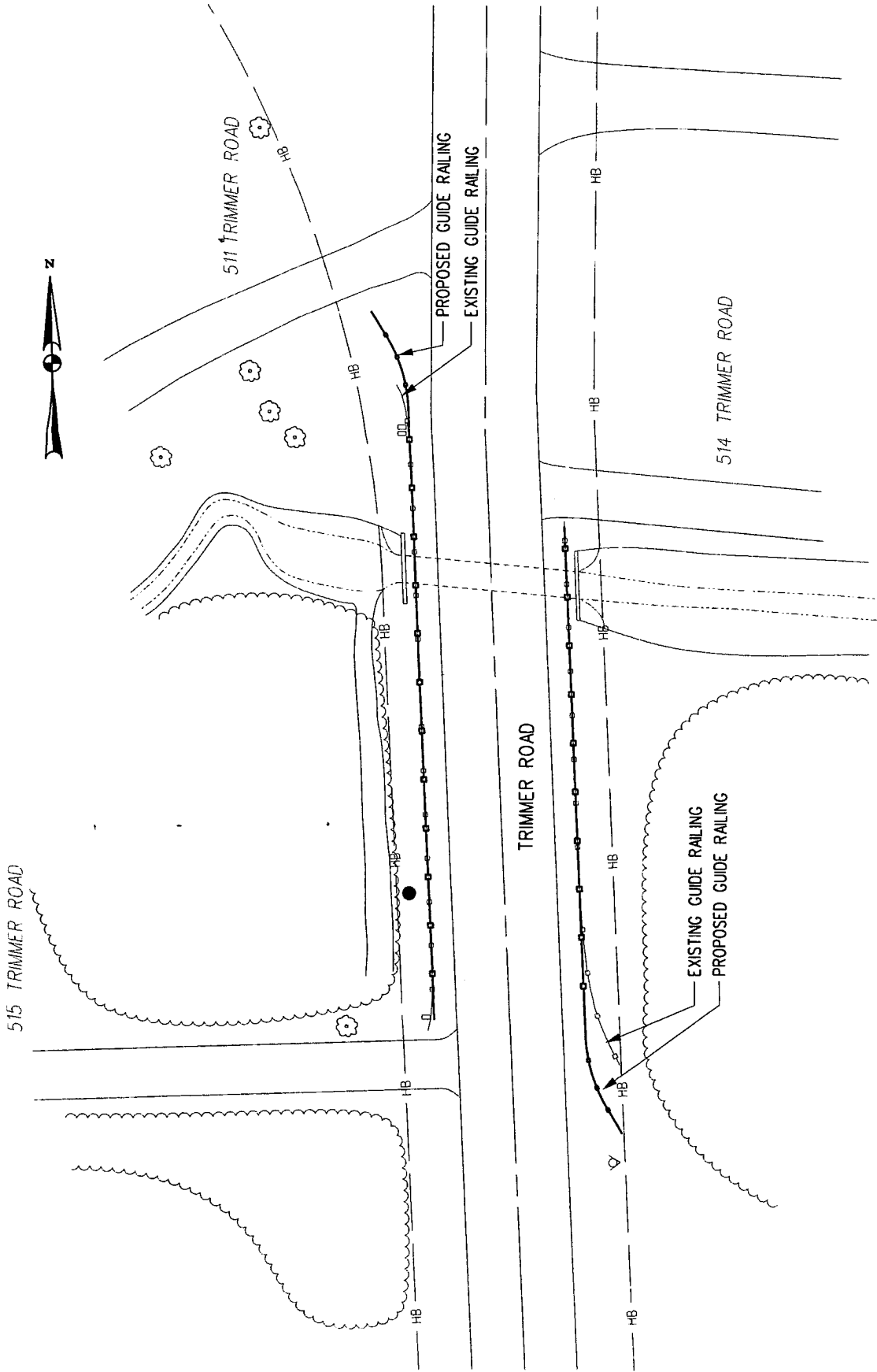
