The meeting of the Royersford Borough Council was called to order at 7:15 p.m. by President Tom Weikel at Royersford Borough Hall, 300 Main Street, Royersford, Pa.

The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was followed by roll call.

Present: M. Bullick, P. Chrisman, A. Dham, J. Kring, A. Metricarti, M. Stehman, and T. Weikel

Also Present: Mayor J. Guest, and Manager M. Leonard

The Treasurers Report and Sewer & Solid Waste Collection Report for March 2015 was presented and accepted upon motion by J. Kring seconded by A. Dham. The motion passed unanimously.

BOROUGH MANAGER'S REPORT:

Manager Leonard reported on the resolution regarding the rental registration and inspection fees. J. Kring suggested that Pennoni set the fee because they will be doing the inspection. The resolution will be on the next council meeting agenda.

Manager Leonard got a quote on replacing two front windows in the police department and two windows in the front of Borough Hall from Graboyes for the cost of \$5,604.00. Motion to purchase the windows from Graboyes by A. Dham seconded by A. Metricarti. Motion passed unanimously.

VISITORS:

Richard Bach Jr., Chairman of Royersford National Night Out Committee, addressed council and asked if they can close the same streets as last year. This year's event will be held on Tuesday August 4, 2015 from 5 pm to 8 pm. The request is to close the following streets at 1:30 pm; Washington Street from 5th Avenue to 3rd Avenue, and 4th Avenue from Walnut to Spring Street. Motion to close the street by M. Bullick seconded by M. Stehman. Motion passed unanimously.

FINANCE COMMITTEE:

Disbursements in the amount of \$134,350.18 were presented and authorized paid upon motion by J. Kring seconded by A. Dham. Motion passed unanimously.

WASTE WATER COMMITTEE:

The report of the Waste Water Treatment Plant Superintendent for the month of March was presented and accepted upon motion of P. Chrisman seconded by A. Dham. The motion passed unanimously.

Andrew Peterson resigned his position at the Waste Water Treatment Plant. Motion to accept Andrew Peterson's resignation with regret by P. Chrisman seconded by M. Bullick. The motion passed unanimously.

The Waste Water Treatment Plant needs to purchase and have installed (2) new weir plates and (1) Eastech 2220 Transmitter with transducer at the cost of \$ 5,275.00. Motion to spend the \$5,275.00 on the two items by P. Chrisman seconded by A. Dham. Motion passed unanimously.

PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE:

The report of the Director of Public Works for the month of March 2015 was presented and accepted upon motion of M. Stehman seconded by M. Bullick. The motion passed unanimously.

The report of the Code Enforcement Officer for the month of March 2015 was presented and accepted upon motion by M. Stehman seconded by A. Metricarti. Motion passed unanimously.

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE:

The report of the Chief of Police for the month of March 2015 was presented and accepted upon motion by M. Bullick seconded by M. Stehman. The motion passed unanimously.

The report of the Royersford Fire Marshal for the month of March 2015 was presented and accepted upon motion by M. Bullick second by A. Metricarti. The motion passed unanimously.

M. Bullick asked for an Executive Session to discuss personnel matters.

PERSONNEL COMMITTEE:

A. Dham reported that the Royersford Business Association will hold a community yard sale on Saturday May 2, 2015.

MAYOR:

Mayor Guest reported on the progress of local police using radar.

Mayor Guest will hold office hours for the public on Wednesday May 20, 2015 from 6PM-8PM and Saturday May 23, 2015 from 10 AM to Noon.

Borough Council went into Executive Session to discuss personnel issues at 7:45p.m. and back out to regular session at 8:00 p.m.
