

May 26, 2015

The regular meeting of the Royersford Borough Council was called to order at 7:15 p.m. by T. Weikel at Royersford Borough Hall, 300 Main Street, Royersford, Pa.

The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was followed by roll call.

Present: M. Bullick, P. Chrisman, A. Dham, J. Kring, A. Metricarti, M. Stehman, and T. Weikel
Also Present: Mayor J. Guest, and Manager M. Leonard

The Treasurers' Report and Sewer & Solid Waste Collection Report for April 2015 was presented and accepted upon motion by J. Kring seconded by A. Dham. Motion passed unanimously.

BOROUGH MANAGER'S REPORT:

Council had a discussion regarding smoking in the park; it was suggested that it should include no smoking in any borough facilities.

Mr. Kring ask if there was any ordinance that mandates that employees, council members and committee members must be in good standing with their sewer and trash bill. A. Dham told council that he thinks Phoenixville tried and there was some kind of law that prevented them from doing that. Manager Leonard stated that he will ask our solicitor and get back to council.

VISITORS:

Keith Kline, 730 Church Street, wanted to speak regarding the property on Third Avenue where the fire company wants to build a new fire company. Mr. Kline was at the meeting to raise concerns regarding the need for more municipal parking.

FINANCE COMMITTEE:

Disbursements in the amount of \$301,082.24, included in that amount is a fire tax disbursement of 95,000.00, were presented and authorized paid upon motion by J. Kring seconded by A. Dham. Motion passed unanimously.

WASTE WATER COMMITTEE:

The report of the Waste Water Treatment Plant Superintendent for the month of April 2015 was presented and accepted upon motion of P. Chrisman seconded by A. Metricarti. The motion passed unanimously.

PARK & RECREATION COMMITTEE:

The minutes of the May 7, 2015 committee meeting were presented and accepted upon motion by A. Metricarti seconded by M. Stehman. The motion passed unanimously.

PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE:

The report of the Code Enforcement Officer for the month of April 2015 was presented and accepted upon a motion by M. Stehman seconded by M. Bullick. The motion passed unanimously.

Craig Keffer, Public Works Director, presented quotes for the salt shed to council for the base price of \$17,782.00 and additional enclosure for the total of \$19,399.00. Motion to purchase the salt bin by A. Dham seconded by M. Stehman. Motion passed unanimously.

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE:

The report of the Chief of Police for the month of April 2015 was presented and accepted by M. Bullick seconded by A. Metricarti. Motion passed unanimously.

M. Bullick informed council that the Chief of Police would like to purchase two solar speed signs from All Traffic Solutions in the amount \$5,990.00 Motion by M. Bullick seconded by A. Dham. The motion passed unanimously.

PERSONNEL COMMITTEE:

A. Dham attended the Upper Providence Township meeting regarding moving the speed sign where it currently is at the borough line back further so the police will be able enforce the speeding in the area. Upper Providence was in favor of moving the sign and was getting a letter to send to Penn Dot along with Royersford's letter.

A. Dham asked for a short executive session at the end of the meeting for personnel reasons.

PLANNING COMMISSION:

The Planning Commission meeting will be held on June 1st at 7 PM to discuss the Royersford Fire Company's new building at 3rd and Walnut Street.

MAYOR:

Mayor Guest also is requesting an executive session regarding personnel.

P. Chrisman asked council if we will be able to use Main Street for Community Day. Manager Leonard sent a letter to Penn Dot notifying them of our Community Day.

Council President Weikel called council into executive session at 7:50 PM; council came out of the executive session at 7:59 PM. No decisions were made.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:00 PM upon a motion by A. Dham seconded by A. Metricarti. The motion passed unanimously.
