

September 8, 2015

The regular meeting of the Royersford Borough Council was called to order at 7:15 p.m. by T. Weikel at Royersford Borough Hall, 300 Main Street, Royersford, Pa.

The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was followed by roll call.

Present: M. Bullick, P. Chrisman, A. Dham, J. Kring, A. Metricarti, M. Stehman, and T. Weikel

Also Present: Mayor J. Guest, Solicitor B. Dunbar, and Manager M. Leonard

The minutes of the August 11 & August 25, 2015 meetings were approved as distributed upon motion of A. Dham seconded by P. Chrisman. Motion passed unanimously.

BOROUGH MANAGER'S REPORT:

Manager Leonard advised Council that he was able to get an extension on the CDBG Grant for Oak Street till August 2016.

VISITORS:

Chris Miller, Manager of the Davey Tree Expert Company 131 E. Church Rd., King of Prussia, Pa. was asking Council if they would be able to use Victory Park this year for the Eastern Tree Climbing Championship on October 3, 2015. Mr. Miller said he would trim some trees in the park for the Borough. There was some discussion by Council regarding the use of the park. Mr. Miller must provide the Borough a certificate of insurance naming the Borough as an insured. Motion by A. Dham seconded by A. Metricarti to allow the tree climbing event at Victory Park. Motion passed by a 6-1 vote with J. Kring voting no.

Daniel Hurd, 226 2nd Avenue was refused a building permit for a fence. Manager Leonard said he would look into the issue.

FINANCE COMMITTEE:

Disbursements in the amount of \$114,804.88 were presented and authorized paid upon motion by J. Kring seconded by A. Dham. Motion passed unanimously.

J. Kring presented the Non-Uniform Pension Plan 2016 Minimum Municipal Obligation (MMO) to Council in the amount of \$51,650.00. Motion by J. Kring seconded by A. Dham to approve the 2016 Non-Uniform MMO. The motion passed unanimously.

J. Kring presented the Police Pension Plan 2016 Minimum Municipal Obligation (MMO) to Council in the amount of \$84,837.00. Motion by J. Kring seconded by A. Dham to approve the 2016 Police MMO. Motion passed unanimously.

PERSONNEL COMMITTEE:

A. Dham spoke to Council regarding the personnel manual.

A. Dham reminded Council that September 12, 2015 is Community Day.

A. Dham advised Council that the movie that was filmed in Royersford previews on Friday September 11, 2015.

PLANNING COMMISSION:
