The regular meeting of the Royersford Borough Council was called to order at 7:15 p.m. by T. Weikel at Royersford Borough Hall, 300 Main Street, Royersford, Pa.

#### BOROUGH MANAGER'S REPORT & COMMUNICATIONS:

Manager Leonard reported that there was one bid on the 2003 International 7400 Dt 466 Trash Truck with Heil Packer Body, rear load 20 yard capacity backup, and camera, with 91,029 miles. Charles Blosenski Disposal Company LLC was the sole bidder in the amount of \$6,000.00. Motion to sell the truck to Charles Blosenski Disposal Company LLC for \$6,000.00 by A. Dham seconded by J.
