The Treasurer's Report and Sewer & Solid Waste Collection Report for September, 2015 was presented and accepted upon motion by J. Kring seconded by A. Dham. Motion passed unanimously.

BOROUGH MANAGER'S REPORT & COMMUNICATIONS:

Manager Leonard reported to Council that an ordinance needs to be advertised for the purchase of police emergency radios from Montgomery County in the amount of \$42,214.00. Motion to advertise the ordinance for consideration by A. Dham seconded by A. Metricarti. Motion passed unanimously.

Manager Leonard reported to Council that Dunkin Donuts donated an outdoor 14' panel Christmas tree. The donation amount was \$4,000.

FINANCE COMMITTEE:

Disbursements in the amount of \$286,898.88 were presented and authorized paid upon motion by J. Kring seconded by A. Dham. The motion passed unanimously.

PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE:

The report of the Director of Public Works for the month of September, 2015 was presented and accepted upon motion of M. Stehman seconded by M. Bullick. Motion passed unanimously.

The Report of the Code Enforcement Officer for the month of September, 2015 was presented and accepted upon motion by M. Stehman seconded by M. Bullick. The motion passed unanimously.

Councilman Stehman thanked Chief Nerlinger and Public Works Director Craig Keffer for all the work they did for the Halloween parade.

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE:

The report of the Chief of Police for the month of September, 2015 was presented and accepted upon motion by M. Bullick seconded by A. Metricarti. The motion passed unanimously.
