The regular meeting of the Royersford Borough Council was called to order at 7:15 p.m. by A. Dham at Royersford Borough Hall, 300 Main Street, Royersford, Pa.

The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was followed by roll call.

The Treasurers Report and Sewer & Solid Waste Collection Report for August 2016 was presented and accepted upon motion by T. Weikel seconded by A. Metricarti. The motion passed unanimously.

BOROUGH MANAGER'S REPORT & COMMUNICATIONS:

Manager Leonard gave an update on the mill and overlay project at 7th Avenue and Oak Street to Borough Council.

Manager Leonard gave some information on the parking lot at 2nd & Arch Street. The storm drain is in bad shape; the bottom of the pipe is rotted out. We are getting prices to see how much it will cost to repair or replace the pipe.

Manager Leonard reported the 2017 estimated liquid fuels allocation is \$120,442.79.

Council President A. Dham reported that our Zoning Solicitor did not adequately represent the Borough's interest at the 601 Arch Street hearing. Council President Dham suggested interviewing other candidates with Crest Club issues coming up and to see what is out there to maybe get better pricing. Council discussed the issue. Motion to put out an advertisement in the newspaper for a Borough Zoning Solicitor by M. Stehman seconded by A. Metricarti. Motion passed unanimously.

Council President distributed the goals of the Borough from the first of the year to see how many were completed.

FINANCE COMMITTEE:

Disbursements in the amount of \$152,404.30 were presented and authorized paid upon motion by T. Weikel seconded by M. Stehman. Motion passed unanimously.

WASTE WATER COMMITTEE:

The report of the Waste Water Treatment Plant Superintendent for the month of August 2016 was presented and accepted upon motion of M. Stehman seconded by M. Bullick. Motion passed unanimously.

PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE:

The report of the Director of Public Works for the month of August 2016 was presented and accepted upon motion of R. Graham seconded by M. Stehman. Motion passed unanimously.

Report of the Code Enforcement Officer for the month of August was presented and accepted upon motion by R. Graham seconded by A. Metricarti. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion to sell the trash truck on Municibid with a reserve of \$85,000.

PARK & RECREATION COMMITTEE:

The minutes of the September 1, 2016 committee meeting were presented and accepted upon a motion by T. Moyer seconded by A. Metricarti. Motion passed unanimously.

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE:
