

March 14, 2017

The regular meeting of the Royersford Borough Council was called to order at 7:15 p.m. by A. Dham at Royersford Borough Hall, 300 Main Street, Royersford, Pa.

The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was followed by roll call.

Present: M. Bullick, A. Dham, A. Metricarti, J. Moskal, T. Moyer, M. Stehman, and T. Weikel

Also Present: Mayor Guest, and Manager M. Leonard

The minutes of the February 14 & February 28, 2017 meeting minutes were approved with one change on the February 28th meeting. Motion by T. Weikel seconded by A. Metricarti. Motion passed unanimously.

BOROUGH MANAGER'S REPORT & COMMUNICATIONS:

Manager Leonard reported on the boat dock at First Avenue & Arch Street. The boat ramp was ordered and should be installed the last week of March.

Manager Leonard reported that we are getting prices on updating the website.

Manager Leonard reported that the borough met with Aliyah Furman from DCED regarding the Façade Grant.

Manager Leonard reported that it would be a good idea to restrict the lower portion of the borough parking lot to 2 hour parking from 7 AM to 4 PM, so that our businesses have parking for their customers. Leonard stated that it could be done on a trial basis. T. Weikel stated that the mayor can proclaim it on a trial basis. Mayor Guest stated that he had some concerns regarding enforcement. It was sent to the public safety committee for comments.

Manager Leonard informed council that he is in the process of getting quotes for updating the borough code book.

Manager Leonard reported to council that he and the engineer met with the school district at Sixth Avenue & Arch Street to discuss the water problem that Mr. Hain has on Arch Street.

Manager Leonard reported that Mr. Lewis would like to put a directory sign up for all his businesses. He would like to erect it on borough property. I told Mr. Lewis he would need an easement from the borough to put the sign up. There was a discussion regarding the easement. Motion by M. Bullick seconded by A. Metricarti to grant the easement to Mr. Lewis. Motion passed unanimously.

VISITORS:

Mr. Paul Chrisman, 750 Main Street, asked who was going to pay for the easement to Mr. Lewis, council responded that Mr. Lewis will pay for the cost of the easement.

FINANCE COMMITTEE:

Disbursements in the amount of \$140,350.09 were presented and authorized paid upon motion by T. Weikel seconded by A Metricarti. The motion passed unanimously.

PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE:

A. Dham reported that the public works department got a lot of positive comments on snow removal, you can tell where Royersford Borough stops and every other municipality starts.

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE:

M. Bullick stated that a resident in the 300 block of Spring Street requested council to install a new street light on Spring Street closest to S. Third Avenue. Mr. Bullick stated it is dark in that area. Manager Leonard stated he would take a look into installing a new light.

MAYOR:

Mayor Guest stated that he has lifted the State of Emergency for the borough.

M. Stehman thanked the police, fire company, EMS, and public works for the work they did during the storm.

ADJOURNMENT:

The meeting was adjourned at 7:36 p.m. upon a motion by T. Weikel seconded by M. Stehman. The motion passed unanimously.
