BOROUGH MANAGER'S REPORT & COMMUNICATIONS:

Manager Leonard reported that the lowest bidder for the Church Street CDBG Grant was Gore Con at \$89,396.48. Motion by T. Weikel seconded by A. Metricarti to accept the lowest bid of Gore Con \$89,396.48 to do the construction on Church Street between 5th & 6th Avenue for the CDBG Grant. Motion passed unanimously.
